JOHN BUCHANAN STIRLING, Presumed heir to feudal Barony of Gargunnoch and as 5th of Gargunnoch (to which he would have s upon the death of his first cousin once removed - but arms have not yet been matric at LO); Lt 2nd Bn Queen's Regt; *b* 15 Dec 1949; *educ* Seaford Coll, and RMA Sandhurst

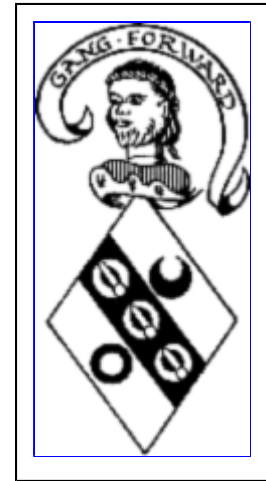
