Secretary to the Edinburgh *Senatus Academicus*, 1833-46. Solicitor of Teinds, 1832-56. Died at 16 Great King Street, Edinburgh, 6th May, 1856. Lord Advocate, 1876-80, and, as such, conducted the prosecution of the Directors of the City of Glasgow Bank in 1879. M.P. for the Universities of Glasgow and Aberdeen, 1876-80.
